copy annexed, adopted on August 01, 2014 by majority vote of the Board of Directors and by the vote of the stockholders owning or representing at least two-thirds of the outstanding capital stock, and certified under oath by the Corporate Secretary and a majority of the Board of Directors of the corporation was approved by the Commission on this date pursuant to the provision of Section 16 of the Corporation Code of the Philippines, Batas Pambansa Blg. 68, approved on May 1, 1980, and copies thereof are filed with the Commission.

Unless this corporation obtains or already has obtained the appropriate Secondary License from this Commission, this Certificate does not authorize it to undertake business activities requiring a Secondary License from this Commission such as, but not limited to acting as: broker or dealer in securities, government securities eligible dealer (GSED), investment adviser of an investment company, close-end or open-end investment company, investment house, transfer agent, commodity/financial futures exchange/broker/merchant, financing company and time shares/club shares/membership certificates issuers or selling agents thereof. Neither does this Certificate constitute as permit to undertake activities for which other government agencies require a license or permit.

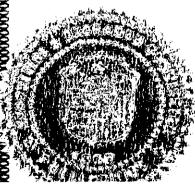

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AMENDED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF MALAYAN INSURANCE COMPANY, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That WE, M. Jesus Cuenco, Enrique T. Yuchengco, Alfonso Yuchengco, Vicencia Yuchengco, married to Eliseo Onglatco, Luisa Yuchengco, married to Victor Lim, Yu Chu and Yu Yek Huy, all of legal age, and residents of the Philippine Islands, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines.

AND WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY

FIRST — That the name of the said corporation shall be **MALAYAN INSURANCE COMPANY, INC.**

SECOND – That the purposes of which said corporation is formed are the following:

- To engage in the business and operation of all kinds of insurance and re-insurance, on sea as well as on land, on goods and merchandise, of transportation or conveyance against fire, against accidents, and all other forms and lines of insurance authorized by law, except life insurance.
- To engage in the business of undertaking for a consideration to indemnify others against loss, damage or liability arising from unknown or contingent events in the following matters and particulars, to wit:
 - a) To guarantee the fidelity of persons holding position of public or private trust, and to execute and guarantee bonds or undertaking in judicial proceedings and to agree to the faithful performance of any contract or undertaking made with any public authority;
 - b) To guarantee and/or counter-guarantee the performance of contracts, agreements, undertakings, obligations, promises or duties, of all kinds;
 - c) To guarantee performance or insurance contracts where security bonds are accepted for such purposes;

- d) To execute and guarantee or counter-guarantee bonds or undertakings of all kinds, required or permitted to be taken in all actions, proceedings, negotiations, importations, exportations, corporations, associations, firms, or by head of departments, courts, judges, officers, boards or bodies whether execute, legislative or judicial;
- e) To guarantee and indemnify merchants, traders, and thoseengaged in business of giving credit, form loss or damage by reason of giving and extending such credit to their customers or persons dealing with them;
- f) As generally, to execute, sign and carry out fidelity bonds and surety undertakings or every nature and kind usual in the business of fidelity and surety companies or permitted by law unto such companies.
- To do and perform any all acts and things and exercise all the general powers authorized by the Corporation law, and to carry out all other acts and things that may be necessary and incidental to accomplish the objects and purposes for which this corporation is organized; and
- 4. To act as agent for other insurance or surety companies, whether domestic or foreign, in any of their lines of business, except life insurance.

THIRD – That the place where the principal office of the corporation is to be located or established shall be at 4/F Yuchengco Tower I, No. 500 Quintin Paredes Street, Binondo, Manila, Metro Manila, Philippines. (As amended on August 01, 2014)

FOURTH – That the period during which said corporation is to exist is 50 years from and after **February 16**, 1999. (As amended on **February 16**, 1998).

SIXTH – That the number of directors of the corporation shall be eleven. (As amended on July 25, 1977).

RESIDENCE

SEVENTH – That the authorized capital stock of the corporation is ONE BILLION FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS (P1,000,500,000.00) Philippine Currency, and said capital stock is divided into TEN MILLION (10,000,000) Common Shares with a par value of One Hundred Pesos (P100.00) per share and Five Thousand (5,000) PREFERRED SHARES with a par value of One Hundred Pesos (P100.00) per share (As amended on August 15, 2001).

Subscription for and ownership of the Preferred Shares of the corporation shall be made and taken on the following conditions:

- a) The holders of preferred shares shall be entitled to receive dividends at the rate of 6% per annum on the par value thereof in Philippine Currency on a cumulative basis whether or nor there are profits available for the purpose.
- b) The dividends on said preferred stock shall be preferential and cumulative, whether or not in any period of the corporation. All dividends paid on the preferred stock shall be paid in chronological order with preference to the due dates for each semi-annual instalment and shall accrue and be cumulative from the date of the issuance thereof. In case any instalment of said dividend is not paid on the dividend payment date of such instalment, then the amount of such instalment shall subsequently be paid before any dividend shall thereafter be paid to holders of common stock. Subject only to

the foregoing limitation, dividends, in cash or in stock, or otherwise, may be paid form time to time to the holders of the common stock from the surplus profits of the corporation in such amounts and when as declared and the holders of the preferred stock shall not be entitled to participate in any such dividends paid to the holders of the common stock. Accumulations of dividends or the preferred stock shall not bear interest. The holders of preferred stock – shall be entitled to no other dividends than as above stated.

- c) In the event of the liquidation, dissolution, receivership, bankruptcy, or winding up of the affairs of the corporation, voluntarily or involuntarily, except in connection with a merger or consolidation, the holders of the preferred stock shall be entitled to be paid in full, at par or ratably, in so far as the assets of the corporation will permit, for each share of preferred stock held, together with the accrued and unpaid dividends thereon, in Philippine Currency, to date of distribution, before any distribution shall be made to the holders of the common stock, and shall be entitled to no other distribution.
- d) The preferred stock shall not be convertible into any other shares of the corporation. (As amended on July 28, 1969).
- e) The holders of the preferred shares have the option to ask the company to redeem the same after a period of ten (10) years at par value, and the company itself may also redeem the shares at par value within a period of ten (10) years form issuance thereof. In all cases of redemption, the following shall be observed:
 - Notice of redemption shall be sent by registered mail to holders
 of the preferred stock to be redeemed to his, her or its address
 as the same appears on the books of the corporation, within
 such reasonable time as the Board of Directors may determine
 and fix;
 - 2) The payment of the redemption price of the shares redeemed shall be made at the office of the company, in Manila, Philippines, and such other place or places, if any, as shall be specified in the notice of such redemption and shall be made upon the surrender of the corresponding certificates of shares redeemed. From and after the date fixed in any such notice as the date of redemption unless the corporation shall fail in the payment of redemption price, dividends on the preferred stock redeemed shall cease to accrue and all rights with respect to said shares of the holders thereof, except the right to receive the redemption price thereof, shall terminate;

- 3) In case of redemption of less than all shares or preferred stock at the outstanding time, the shares of the preferred stock to be redeemed shall be selected by the corporation by lot or in such other equitable manner as the Board of Directors of the corporation shall determine;
- 4) If less than all the shares of the preferred stock represented by any certificate are redeemed at any one time, the holders shall be entitled to receive a new preferred stock certificate reflecting the unredeemed shares of preferred stock.
- f) If the original purchaser of the preferred shares is a non-resident alien not engaged in business in the Philippines, and the purchase price is paid in U.S. Dollars, the redemption price shall be paid in the same currency, subject to the laws of the Philippines obtaining at the time of the redemption.
- g) The holders of preferred stock shall not be entitled to any voting rights except those expressly provided by law.

The above terms and conditions must be printed on the face of the certificates of stock. (As amended on August 21, 1962)

EIGHT – That the amount of said capital stock which has been actually subscribed is **TWO HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND PESOS** (P250,000.00), Philippine Currency, and the following persons have subscribed for the number of shares and the amount of capital stock has set forth opposite their respective names:
